<u>Purpose:</u> Spanish I is the introductory course given to the student to help him or her in fulfilling their role as vital and productive members of an increasingly bilingual society. The student will be introduced to basic and fundamental skills in the use of the Spanish language that includes speaking, reading, listening, and writing in their target language.

<u>Objectives:</u> To help each student acquire basic and fundamental skills needed in order to communicate effectively in the target language with Spanish-speakers in our society, and to develop appreciation for varied aspects of Hispanic culture: its traditions, customs historical and geographical data.

GRADING PROCEDURES & WEIGHTS:

The nine-week averages will consist of the following:

Classwork/Homework - 30%
Oral activities / presentations
Quizzes - 15%
Test / Projects - 35%

Late work: Late work will receive a deduction of 10 points. More than one week late will receive a deduction of 25 points. (Late work rule does not apply when student has an excused absence.)

Retesting policy: Students who have received a grade lower than a 70 on a test can retest. Time and date for retesting will be determined by teacher.

NOTE: Quizzes, Semester or Final Exams cannot be retested.
